RoHS Compliance Statement

QStar is collaborating with our suppliers to comply with the European Union Restriction of the Use of Hazardous Substances in Electrical and Electronic Equipment ("RoHS") Directive (2002/95/EC), taking effect July 1, 2006. The RoHS directive prohibits the sale of electronic equipment containing certain hazardous substances such as lead, cadmium, mercury, hexavalent chromium, polybrominated biphenyls ("PBB") and polybrominated diphenylethers ("PBDE") in the European Union.

While it only affects one QStar product we are taking RoHS very seriously and have initiated a program to ensure that our SentryStor Archive Appliance satisfies the RoHS Directive with respect to the various categories of electronic products.

QStar is committed to fully comply with the RoHS Directive on or before July 1, 2006. All of our standard products will be designed (or redesigned) to be RoHS-compliant to meet the compliance date. At this time, however, we cannot set specific release dates for the new RoHS-compliant QStar products because of the tentative schedule for the availability of RoHS-compliant components.
